# - Activity and Services

We are requesting funds to help us provide a Youth Stage at the 10th Anniversary of the Mangonui Festival.

We wish to bring back Youth that have performed over the 10 years to recognise and celebrate their growth. As such, we would like to be able to pay each performer a reasonable Koha that recognises their work and their value.

Mangonui Festival Organisers will this year endeavour to help us with the costs of the staging.

Over the years we have found that holding a Youth Stage at the Mangonui Festival provides an opportunity for Youth from our wider region - Bay of Islands to Kaitaia, to perform and to collaborate. It highlights the availability of our programme and helps the Youth in their self confidence and self esteem. Be Free Youth work alongside the stage and help in its management, PR and supporting all those other Youngsters that join us on this day. The stage will incorporate both song and dance.

# Getting our message heard

Our Youth demonstrate through performance what they can achieve through learning resilience which gives them the strength to exercise their educated choices around non-participation in drug and alcohol use. We find delivering our messages through the medium of music is not only readily accepted, but is cross cultural, breaking down any barriers. The medium is far more effective to their peers (and whanau) when delivered by the youth themselves.

Feedback received from attendees at the 2020 Festival was one of surprise and pride at the high level of musicianship shown by our Youngsters, and encouragement given for those who were performing in public for the first time. As usual, we received applications for youngsters to join the Be Free Mentoring through Music programme as a result of the performances given by Youth on this stage at the Mangonui Festival. During the event, attendees are able to access support and resources, engaging with support providers.
