



Policy # 4106 – ROAD MAINTENANCE

Adopted by Council:

Transfund New Zealand provides funding assistance for all of the Council's basic road maintenance.

The Council's road maintenance programme accounts for the majority of its total annual roading expenditure.

The Council has adopted a Road Asset Maintenance Management System (RAMM's). This is a management tool for collecting data relevant to arriving at decisions on where, what type and what level of maintenance should be applied to roads.

- 1 General road maintenance (and daily management thereof), of all roads and associated roading features which are the responsibility of the Far North District Council, shall be contracted out on the basis of competitive tendering. The activities specifically covered by this contract shall include:
 - Pavement surface maintenance;
 - Minor pavement restoration;
 - Drainage maintenance;
 - Vegetation control;
 - Minor maintenance of bridge superstructure;
 - Maintenance of safety furniture.

In addition, the contract shall make provision for:

- Emergency works (e.g. clearing slips etc); and
