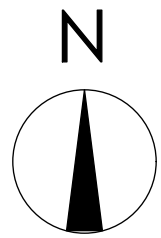

Enhancement of the Pa site fomation through weed removal, thus revealing of the Pa terraces and increasing the visibility of the two Pa sites that flank the harbour entrance.

Existing weeds to be carefully and progressively removed and replaced with grass/lawn.

Access track from Pa to beach.

Information board on Rangitoto Pa, also identifying the Reserve areas and Private property boundaries.

Proposed screen planting to hide the private driveway through the Reserve and enhance the sense of remoteness experienced when visiting the Pa site.

Existing Native Vegetation to remain.

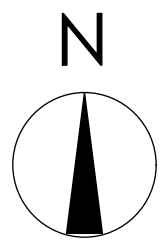
