





- 10-12.30 Te Koukou Two delegations to the Roading Komiti
   Paula Mathews re Pairatahi Rd , Kaingaroa . Application to tarseal road. 6 residents have developed cancer, 3 have died recently. Residents oppose further subdivision without tarseal. Dust. Video shows poor drainage issues during flooding- often signed off with no repairs.
- **Mina Pomare** said Panguru community were critical of the roading matrix that NTA have developed, to delay the repairs of their roads in Motutī and Panguru . Locals have records of many events that are hosted in their area which are not accounted for by NTA road watchers one or 2 days . Non engagement with locals- lazy research used to justify not repairing the hazardous roads. Pā Henare Tate, Joe Cooper , Moka Puru, Aperahama mā all fought for our people. One of the bridges is held together with chicken wire. Where is the equity? Talk to us.


