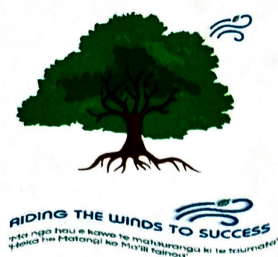

Re: Introduction of Speed Bumps on Settlers Way, Ōkaihau

We are writing to bring to your attention an ongoing concern regarding speeding vehicles along Settlers Way, Ōkaihau. This is a concern for both residents and pedestrians, and we are concerned about the potential for further accidents if this matter is not addressed soon.

As you may be aware, there was a recent road fatality on Settlers Way involving a speeding vehicle. This incident has had a significant impact on our small community.

Many of us have noticed that speeding vehicles, particularly during peak hours, are frequently on our road, putting our ākonga at risk. The speed limits are often disregarded, and the lack of adequate traffic calming measures makes the situation even more dangerous, particularly for families with children, the elderly, and those who regularly walk in the area.

In response to these concerns, a petition has been started by the Ōkaihau Community Association and this is well supported by a large number of residents. We believe that the implementation of solutions such as speed bumps, clearer signage, or additional traffic monitoring could significantly improve the situation and ensure the safety of everyone in our community.

We encourage you to take the community feedback on board and implement steps to help reduce the speed along Settlers Way. We are happy to discuss this issue further and collaborate on finding the best solutions for our community.

Thank you for your attention to this important issue. We trust that, with your support, we can make Ōkaihau a safer place for everyone.






