Butler wrote "I trust that this day will be remembered with gratitude, and its anniversary kept by ages yet unborn. Each heart rejoiced in this auspicious day and said, I may God speed the plough". 	Second Preference	Huakiwi Place	1	Maori name for kiwifruit, one of the most thriving horticultural products of Kerikeri.
