The 2020 Korowaitanga had officially begun. 56 Akonga (graduates), their supporters, dignataries, Kohanga Reo Head Office representatives & respected Kaumatua & Kuia. Inside the kauta a buzz of activity as the cooks were preparing the kai for morning tea & the hakari, the dining room crew were setting tables; black table cloths, red & black runners & the hand made centre pieces, *impressive, just impressive*

After a lavish morning tea it was back into the Marae, to start the Korowaitanga; with the announcing of all the graduates, starting with *Te Ata Raukura*, *Takaimatua*, *Te Ara Tuatahi*, *Te Ara Tuarua* & finally the Akonga who had graduated with the *Whakapakari Tohu*. The taonga were given out "kono" filled with a dice, medallion, honey, soap, pick up sticks, a kohanga kete and the graduates certificates.

Finally the Whakapakari Akonga proudly wearing their whanau korowai *tino ataahua*; receiving their Maori kete filled with natural & harakeke made resources, a kohanga kete and their graduates certificates.

Hakari, mihihihi, waiata, korero, more waiata, more kai, more korero.....

We feel the communities will benefit economically & by increasing opportunities for growth as many people are now staying within our areas & shopping locally,
