The Hullabaloo Children's Arts Festival will present an 8day programme of high-quality kids entertainment set against the backdrop of the stunning Far North region.

Events and activities contribute greatly to a community, bringing vibrancy and a sense of place. The festival will cater to the local family market, bringing shows to the region that rarely make it past Whangarei. There will be special locations used as venues, such as Waitangi Treaty Grounds, Puketi Forest and The Pioneer Village.

Hullabaloo will feature award-winning artists such as The Wonky Donkey Man, Anika Moa, Chris Sanders and Capt Festus McBoyle. Whilst our hub will be in Waitangi and also appeal to tourists to the region, we feel it is important to run an outreach programme that takes shows to more under-served parts of the Far North. We have negotiated significantly reduced fees with the artists for these shows as they understand that capacities are small and we must keep the admission price affordable. However there are still a cost to every show in addition to a fee; sound equipment, accommodation, travel to the venue, refreshments, marketing and staffing costs.

We have participated in many outreach programmes in the past within other arts festivals, these have been hugely successful and rewarding experiences for artists, festival staff and attendees, we have a great desire to incorporate this into our new festival offering as we know the benefits can be huge.

We will take 2 shows to Totara North, the first show featuring Chris Sanders would be aimed at kids from 5 – 10 years. Chris was nominated for a NZ Music Award this year for his work, which includes the 111 – Call for the Ambulance song. This teaches kids what to do in an emergency and he has been honoured by St John Ambulance, had a 2-week run of his show commissioned by WHOA!

The second show features Anika Moa with her *Songs for Bubbas*. Aimed at parents with young children 0-6 years, Anika has won countless awards and is one of New Zealand's most well-known entertainers.
