Update:

The Northland Transportation Alliance (NTA) contracted with NCC Consulting Engineers to perform a post construction Road Safety Audit for the Pa Road Project which is attached to this document. The audit identified road safety concerns and made recommendations to the project manager for corrective actions. Although all concerns raised should be considered for action, the project manager will decide what course of action is required based on the guidance given in the NZTA ranking process (Table included below) and also by considering factors other than safety.

Concern	Suggested action	
Serious	Major safety concern that must be addressed and requires changes to avoid serious safety consequences	
Significant	Significant concern that should be addressed and requires changes to avoid serious safety consequences	
Moderate	Moderate concern that should be addressed to improve safety	
Minor	Minor concern that should be addressed where practical to improve safety	

The Road Safety Audit also acts as a decision tracking mechanism, documenting the designer, safety engineer and client decision and informing future long term plan projects. After reviewing the audit please advise if you have any additional questions on either the project or the audit results.
