Background

Since the photo taken in December 2018, the Freese Park foreshore has continued to deteriorate rapidly.

This coastal erosion has affected several Council assets including a picnic table, rubbish bin and what appeared to be old pipe work etc.

However, the speed of this deterioration is now putting not only putting council assets at risk e.g.: playground and public toilet facilities but also neighbouring property asset's e.g.: fencing.
