Date	Event
1987 aprox	Fundraising began by Rangitane Residents Association
21 June 1992	Jetty Opening Day
29 July 2001	1) FNH Letter to Kerikeri Community Board Chairman Doug Turner re proposed redevelopment of Rangitane Boat Ramp. 2) Design plans for a double ramp at Rangitane received by Community Board.
25 Aug 2005	Incorporation Achieved for Rangitane Residents Association
2009 - 2010	TWICE the Rangitane Residents Association was asked to apply for \$80K available from Community Board. A Residents Association Committee member was asked to write the letter of request but the letter was not written
10 Oct 2016	NRC approved Resource Consent for Sea Bed Licence & supporting plans for the jetty structure.
2017	\$1,000. donated to Rangitane Residents Assoc for repairs to the Jetty. Repairs were not carried out and donation was asked by donor to be re-donated to Aroha Island & BOI Coast Guard.
Oct 2018	Rangitane Residents Association gifted 2 x 12metre x 4 metre plus a steel gangway. Residents notified in October Newsletter.
3 Sept 2018	Ray Hatch Email to Chronicle about intended removal of Rangitane Jetty by Rangitane Residents Association .
13 Sept 2018	Bay Chronical Article Published - SAVE OUR JETTY
Sept 2018	KK Cruising Club were replacing piles in the marina. 12 piles were available to the Rangitane Residents Association for repairs to the Jetty. Steven DeRuiter offered the use of the barge building his private Jetty to punch in the piles on the Rangitane Jetty. Ray Hatch offered some costs towards this but there was no Residents Association Committee available that could make a decision.
Oct - Dec 2018	1) A 35 meter Jetty Built by Steven DeRuiter - Quotes \$229K & \$220K inc gst Plus Resource Consent costs. 2) Rangitane Residents Association , at their Consultation meeting on the Reserve held on 1 March 2020, suggest they can replace the existing Rangitane Jetty, minus gangway & pontoon, for \$56,120 .this does not including consent costs. And in our opinion Grossly underestimated.
25 Nov 2018	1) Letter from Rangitane Residents Association to BOI & Whangaroa Community Board. 2) This letter offers the Rangitane Jetty to the FNDC / FNH transferring the current Resource Consent.
2 Dec 2018	Rangitane Residents Association Public Meeting - AGM - informed Residents that 4 pontoons & a gangway have been gifted for the jetty.
4 Dec 2018	Rangitane Residents Association letter to FNH confirming Committee resolved to offer the Resource Consent/s held in respect of the marine structures at the Rangitane boat ramp area, over to the Council. (RRAI committee meeting on 2 December 2018.)
10 Dec 2018	Presentation to Community Board to Offer the Rangitane Jetty to the FNDC. Presentation included 'Resource Consent', 210 signatures in support of handing over to FNH, misc letters & photos.

4 Mar 2019	Rangitane Residents Association Incorporation Dissolved by NZ Companies Office. Due to not submitting required paperwork.
4 April 2019	1) Meeting at Rangitane boatramp to hear proposal & upgrade to include a parking area by way of re-claiming an area adjacent to jetty. 2) Meeting - attendees - Hugh Rihari, Richard Civil, Bruce Buckland, John Neison, John MacKinney, Ray Hatch and a couple of other locals.
5 April 2019	Hugh Rihari email received, regarding meeting at Rangitane boat ramp on 4 April 2019
13 May 2019	Gordon Dellar letter - to Bruce, Richard, Ray, Doug T, Chris - RE: Concept drawings.
July 2019	Parking for Boat Ramp at Rangitane' is identified as an issue in the FNDC Flyer in rates notices - Creating Great Places, News about FNDC projects in 2019/20. Funding proposed in Councils next annual or long term plan.
April - Sept 2019	Working Group' Meetings held at Ray Hatch's home. Attendees were Bruce Buckland, John McKinney, John Neison, Doug Turner, Doug Kinnon, Jeff Christensen, Jo Civil & Ray Hatch
15 July 2019	1st Drawing received by John Neison, Chair of Rangitane Residents Association , 15 July 2019 (hand drawn) he did not pass this on to the committee until 28 July via email. (2 weeks later)
28 July 2019	1) John Neison emailed Rangitane Residents Assoc about drawing. 2) Drawing kept to a select few within the Committee. It was NOT SHARED with the community.
12 Sept 2019	Email from Chris Galbraith which included Original 3 x concept drawings for Rangitane Boat ramp & Jetty re-development
29 Sept 2019	1) AGM of Rangitane Residents Assoc. at Rangitane Reserve. 2) The Chairmans report, at the Residents Association AGM, included that in February 2019 there was a presentation made to the BOI/Wharngaroa Community Board to pass over ther ownership of the Jetty & current NRC Resource Consent to the Council. Citing that it was beyond the means of the Association. 3) At the Residents Association AGM the then 'Working Group' had a display board available with up to date information on the 3 x options of the FNH Concept drawings, photo's of the Rangitane area, a suggestion form & support form for signatures. The 29.7.2001 FNH proposed redevelopment letter & drawings also displayed. 4) Committee elected : John Neison Chair, Ray Hatch Vice chair, Jeff Christensen Treasurer, Secretary Casey Gannon, Committee Jo Civil, Adrian Walker, Blair Stanley, Mandy Griffin, Katherine Pankhurst
29 Sept 2019	Working Group - Began collecting signatures in support of proposed Maritime Facilities for Rangitane.
12 Oct 2019	1) Meeting held by people concerned that Residents Association Committee hijacked by NIMBY group. A decision was made to form another local Association 2) Rangitane Recreation Association was formed.
14 Oct 2019	Process of Incorporation Started for Rangitane Recreation Association
15 Oct 2019	Process of Building a WEBSITE began for Rangitane Recreation Association.
30 Oct 2019	Rangitane Residents Association Revocation of Dissolution by NZ Companies Office.

11 Dec 2019	1) Committee Meeting Rangitane Residents Association. Committee voted that Ray Hatch has a conflict of interest re his involvement in the Rangitane Recreation Assoc. 2) Ray Hatch requested committee approval for repairs to take place on the Rangitane Jetty at no cost to the Rangitane Residents Association . Ray advised that at the low tide, on 13 Dec, permission has been granted from the Harbour masters office and Piles are available from FNH. He said Bruce Buckland Transport has made an excavator available to punch in piles for Rangitane Jetty. But the Committee declined his offer as they voted he had a conflict of interest. 3) Tabled letter by Ray Hatch suggesting committee members on a personal crusade should start their own group if they do not want a new Jetty & parking rather than use the Residents Association as a platform for their own agenda.
