Kaitāia: Initial engagement with mana whenua was carried out in 2021 (with representatives of four Rūnanga: Te Rarawa, Ngāi Takoto, Ngāti Kahu, Te Aupōuri). Initial landowner engagement with the highest 15 ranked sites has commenced and is expected to be completed by mid-April 2022. Following completion of initial landowner engagement, in-person meetings will be scheduled with landowners who have expressed an interest in the project, to work towards identifying a preferred site for undertaking physical site investigations and development of concept design and estimates. Engagement with Rūnanga representatives has commenced to discuss sites of interest as we progress towards identifying a preferred site. The replacement resource consent to authorise discharges from the WWTP to water has been lodged with NRC and placed on hold at the request of FNDC to enable further mana whenua engagement., Kaikohe: Initial engagement with mana whenua is occurring through a formal mechanism with representatives from three hapū (Te Uri o Hua, Ngāti Whakaeke, Ngāti Tautahi). FNDC is establishing a working group with representatives from these hapū, and we are currently in the final stages of agreeing terms of reference for the group. Once the terms are agreed, staff anticipate the working group will be formalised and investigations into wastewater discharge to land options can commence as a task of the working group. Landowner engagement has not commenced, this will occur once the working group has progressed together to this stage of the project. The replacement resource consent to authorise discharges from the WWTP to water has been lodged with NRC and placed on hold at the request of FNDC, while mana whenua engagement occurs via the working group. , In accordance with s124 of the RMA, FNDC is authorised to continue to discharge treated wastewater from both community WWTP to water while the resource consent applications are processed by NRC.
