INTRODUCTION

1. We the community of Kaikohe Would like permission to ***'Create a Great Place'***. We would like to build a full size 'multi-purpose' basketball court at Kaikohe Memorial Park, which also offers Free Wi-Fi. The park in which we believe is governed by the Kaikohe and Hokianga Community Board.
2. In order to achieve this we are also seeking from you by way of board resolution 'seed funding' to kick this project off. We trust as you read further on, this project coincides with multiple projects identified within your strategic plan. AND we would love this project to be completed and ready for a formal ribbon cutting and maiden basketball game in order to christen the new facility and hand it over to the community by November 2018.
3. Before you think basketball is a sport and therefore Memorial Park is not the ideal space for this project there is more than sufficient evidence that states this is the perfect location. An outdoor basketball court is not seen as a sporting facility it is in fact seen and classed as an **'urban concept'**. There are numerous venues throughout New Zealand whereby there outdoor 'multi purpose' courts coincide with skate parks i.e Kerikeri, Hooton reserve Albany, Victoria park Auckland.
4. Many Council's large and small have already got behind and provided their communities with outdoor courts. Auckland, Cambridge, Te Awamutu, Palmerston North, New Plymouth, Christchurch attached **'B'** page 8
5. After hearing a range of appeals from children and families within our community and which became more evident through our current petition, a copy of which is attached to our submissions marked **'D'** page 12, We are here, as a vessel, for their voice to be heard; whilst also critically exploring strategies to achieve and maintain positive change and lifestyles for whanau.
6. There is an overall general consensus that Kaikohe residents yearn to see their beloved town do a complete turnaround; to rise from the depths and be fruitful in their achievements. We believe that through sports we are able to achieve this. By offering state of the art venues and by being the most central point of the Far North District commonly known as the 'Hub of the North' we are in the perfect location to use sports to our advantage. By having something as 'small' as a full sized outdoor basketball court we are opening doorways to opportunities and bringing the people to 'US' this in turn brings population which only but helps our local economy.
7. There is a 3x3 National Basketball Tour held every year throughout New Zealand which travels around 14 different venues, the furthest location north currently is Auckland. It makes sense that we provide a

venue for this as the 'Hub of the North' and capitalise on it in any which way we are able. Not to mention the great publicity it will give for our town.

8. We are ALL aware of the negative publicity, attached to our community at present, with crime and violence predicted to be on the rise. With a swell of 'alcohol and methamphetamine abuse' in conjunction with the rise and sways of 'gangs' this is adding more pressure to the many families that are already experiencing adversity within their homes.

RELEVANT FACTS

9. This initiative is focussed on creating a 'safe hub' that ignites and generates whanaungatanga, providing free access to and in conjunction with addressing, enhancing and restoring healthier lifestyles in order to bring about positive and sustainable change.
10. *In 2014 New Zealand NBA superstar Steven Adams, Spark Telecommunications and the Auckland Council joined together to create the 'Spark Boroughs project', an initiative that focussed on providing the community a safe space to gather and play 'ball' in hope of connecting basketball players at all courts. Part of this connectivity was providing free WIFI at the courts. It was believed that the blend of good old-fashioned exercise and new ways of staying in touch would create a community space that everyone could enjoy. "The purpose of the Boroughs project was 'to create spaces where Auckland young people could engage with a sport they love, in the ways they wanted to.*
11. This concept also fits perfectly with our local board's vision and priority to provide opportunities for people in our community to increase physical activity through leisure activities and deter crimes. *The Kaikohe Hokianga Community Board supports*
 - **Community Connectivity** - *Increased opportunities for high speed internet and improved cellphone coverage*
 - *Better facilities for youth, disabled and elderly in our communities*
 - *Maintain and enhance our existing facilities infrastructure, CBDs, Parks and Reserves, Halls, sporting facilities, walkways and recreational infrastructure, street lighting gardens and historic landmarks of significance that forms the basis of community life and identity*
 - *Maintaining and enhancing visitor and community gateways to Kaikohe Hokianga*
 - *Our towns and communities as gateways to important tourist destinations and tourist attractions*
12. According to Sports New Zealand, basketball numbers are on the rise and they have not seen this many interested numbers since the 90's. The New Zealand Basketball Association also claimed that *the increasing numbers are ASTOUNDING and are STILL on the rise. A national crisis has occurred, where there are no longer enough courts to satisfy the demand; hence our plea to secure this resource for our own community.*

13. In the Kaikohe district alone, there are numerous students between the ages of 11 and 19 that currently perform at high levels of Basketball, and have been proudly selected to represent Ngapuhi and Te Tai Tokerau, both nationally and internationally.
14. Currently, there are no courts that are freely available to practice, train and play on, which is financially impacting on children and whanau within our area. Many of our families are transporting their children to the Waipapa/Kerikeri area to engage in sports; to access their facilities due to the limited resources here in our own town. This is far from ideal considering coaches are also travelling from Kaikohe to Waipapa to train Kaikohe and Hokianga Children. During term one of the 2018 year a 'junior jam' skills and drills was held at northland college thus seeing 30-40 children attend with the desire for it to continue throughout the year. The Kaikohe intermediate school took their children away to the AIMS games. As described earlier, 'Spark Boroughs project' is a testament of a successful ,community driven story'; right here in New Zealand; one that we want to mirror image. Based on this projects fruitful outcome, it is evident that this initiative is realistic and attainable. Therefore, this is an initiative that we know will make a difference; one that we know will be utilised; and one that we have identified to be very successful.

SUMMARY

15. The ideal concept for Kaikohe is building Memorial Park up and adding onto the concrete slab that is currently already there 'which contains a backboard without a hoop' in order to gain a full sized basketball court along with offering a free wi-fi hotspot during daylight hours. (Winter hours from 8am to 5.30pm and summer hours from 6am to 8.30pm). We are hoping either Ministry of social Development, Ministry for Vulnerable Children formerly known as Child youth and Family or MacDonalds will be willing to jump on board with this initiative and sponsor the Free Wi-Fi Component of our plan.



16. Basketball New Zealand published an '*Outdoor Facilities Guide*'. The guide is designed to assist public or Private Organisations in developing Court Facilities, which gives a comprehensive overview on the what to do and what not to do's.

17. Outdoor Courts;
- i. Must meet minimum standards in terms of court size and markings
 - i. have been demonstrated to have a **positive** impact in the **urban** environment.

- ii. should be in highly visible locations – which assists in minimising anti-social behaviour. It will also be a popular readily available location for holiday programmes which will maximise the use of the site.
- iii. Flexibility to provide a full/half-court with an additional hoop on the side
- iv. Facilities should be co-located with other activities
- v. Multi-sport markings – makes the court versatile

18. Outdoor Court Design Considerations to avoid page 20 Outdoor Facilities Guide

- i. Court is too small and is an inappropriate shape
- ii. There are no line markings
- iii. Poor hoop design i.e (no hoop at all) hoop not at the correct standard height
- iv. Poor hoop design



19. Kaikohe currently has an urban court completed with all of the listed Design Considerations to avoid.

20. Basketball New Zealand state that ‘where these factors combine together, outdoor basketball courts will be well utilised, anti-social behaviour will be minimised, they will add to the appeal of the area as a destination and the high level of use will contribute towards the passive surveillance of the area.

21. Adding in the additional factor - Free Wi-Fi. Wi-Fi will attract numbers to the urban park.

CONCLUSION

22. We trust this is an initiative that the Community Board will find delight in backing us with and one we know the community will utilise. We already have the support of Basketball New Zealand and Northland Basketball their letters of support are attached and Marked 'A' pages 6 and 7. It really isn't an opportunity anyone would want to pass up as we believe we have the next small town Steven Adams destined for the NBA in amongst our communities group of youths so therefore as a community we want to be 'backing them' in any which way possible.
23. The Long Term Plan and the FNDC currently have funds allocated and a plan to build a toilet block at Memorial park in the 2019/2020 year, which tells us this venue is well utilised hence the perfect location for this project. It may be a great opportunity to bring this forward to the current year and have both projects opened together.
24. This project also coincides with the Sport and Recreation Facilities Review dated 2015, this document clearly outlines the need for a basketball court at Memorial Park, albeit a 3 x 3 court, however given this document has now aged 3 years and there is evidence to show basketball numbers have grown and continue to grow we therefore propose a Full sized and Multi Purpose Court.
25. I will personally follow this project through to completion and am readily available when called upon.
26. Furthermore once this court is up and running and proving to be the success we know it to be, we then propose to erect a multi-purpose court within Omapere/Opononi Coastal Park location, with multi-sport options such as volleyball, netball, tennis and basketball, the range of activities help to promote the area as a holiday destination, really the opportunities are endless and the ground work will have already been completed tested and proven.

Build basketball court in park near skate bowl.

Park currently grassed and flat.
Access in from east end.
No known drainage in the area.
Dry weather work only.

From site visit and specifications supplied, we understand:

- The court should be orientated north/south.
- Total area 32m x 19m
- One degree slope from longitudinal centre line to sides (which equates to approx 1.5%) for stormwater drainage off court.
- Rubberised membrane surface to be added by others along with court markings.
- Court base can be either hotmix or concrete.

With flat contour and lack of drainage we think it prudent to build concrete base, rather than 200mm of compacted metal foundation with concrete nib edging and 25mm hotmix. (Cost will be similar anyway)

If base was built bigger it could fit a netball court 38m x 23m and a tennis court 35m x 17m?

- Establish on site and cordon off.
- Set out court.
- Remove topsoil and dump locally (assume 100mm deep)
- Excavate subgrade 100m to allow for 100mm compacted metal foundation under 100mm of concrete base.
- Supply and lay geo-textile cloth in bottom of excavation.
- Supply, cart place to levels and compact Gap40 metal foundation.
- Box outside edges of court.
- Final preparation on foundation for 100mm concrete.
- Supply and install goal post sleeves.
- Supply and install 665 reinforcing mesh in court base.
- Supply 20Mpa concrete and pump and lay 100mm thick.
- Sawcut expansion joints.
- Strip boxing and topsoil around edges of court.
- Supply and fit 2 goals into sleeves.
- Dis-establish site.

Please Note:

1. Cracking: It is common for newly laid concrete to form cracks either before or after formed or saw cut expansion joints are installed. Whilst we try to mitigate against this it is beyond our control.
2. Colour Variation/Pinto effect: When laying tinted concrete with colour oxides there can be some colour variation across the surface caused by different drying conditions e.g. shaded areas vs full sun. Whilst this can be quite obvious at initial placement it does eventually even out with time.
3. Colour Fading: Coloured concrete will fade and bleach in colour depth and consistency as a consequence of natural exposure to sunlight.
4. Surface Finishing: We offer a range of different surface finishes for concrete. Please ensure you understand the surface finish you are getting before we place concrete as it is permanent.
5. We have a wide range of concrete colours available. These can be viewed on request.

TERMS OF ENGAGEMENT

1. Credit

Payment for services and goods (called "the Works") provided by ROBINSON ASPHALTS 1992 LTD (called "the Contractor") to the Customer, if provided on credit, shall be made to the Contractor strictly in accordance with the Terms of Payment specified in the quotation (called "the due date").

2. Penalty Interest

If the Customer fails to pay for the Works on the due date, the Contractor reserves the right:

- To charge interest on any such payment not made at a rate which is three per cent (3%) over and above the current overdraft interest rate charged by the Contractor's current bank from the due date of payment in full.
- To recover from the Customer all costs and expenses of or incurred by the Contractor in collecting the overdue account(s) including debt collectors' costs and legal costs.

3. Title

Title to goods supplied by the Contractor as part of the Works (called "the goods") is retained by the Contractor and will pass to the Customer only when:

- All the Contractor's invoices in respect of the Works have been paid for in full, and
- All other goods supplied to the Customer by the Contractor under any other agreement under which the title in those goods is retained by the Contractor until payment, and which have not been paid for in full, have been paid for in full.

The Customer is a fiduciary in relation to the goods supplied and shall hold the goods as bailee for the Contractor. Therefore:-

- The goods shall at all times be situated at the land or premises of the Customer on which the Contractor undertakes the Works and records shall be maintained by the Customer so that the Contractor can readily identify its property.

4. If:-

- The Customer fails to observe or perform any of these terms of engagement ("the Terms") or the terms and conditions of any other arrangement made between the Customer and the Contractor under which the title in any other goods supplied under that arrangement is still retained by the Contractor, or
- The Customer being an incorporated company ceases or threatens to cease to carry on business or a petition is presented or an order is made or an effective resolution is passed for the winding up of the Customer or if a Receiver is appointed or if in the opinion of the Contractor the Customer is unable to pay its debts or is likely to go into liquidation or receivership or if the Customer seeks a re-organisation, restructure, arrangement, adjustment or composition of its debts, or
- The Customer being an individual is adjudged bankrupt or in the opinion of the Contractor is unable to pay his debts or is likely to be adjudged bankrupt or if the Customer seeks a restructure, arrangement or adjustment or composition of the Customer's debts

- then the period of credit is immediately determined and the Contractor by its servants and agents may immediately without giving the Customer any notice or waiting any time, retake possession of the goods or any other goods provided by the Contractor under any other arrangement under which title in those goods is still retained by the Contractor.

If the Contractor shall be entitled to regain possession of the goods, then the Customer gives the Contractor leave and licence for its servants and agents to enter and remain upon any land or premises wherein the goods which, in the opinion of the Contractor, may be and take possession of the said goods. Goods so repossessed may be resold by the Contractor at the absolute discretion of the Contractor.

5. Risk

Risk in the goods shall pass to the Customer upon integration of the goods in the Works of the Works by the Contractor.

6. Force Majeure

The Contractor shall not be liable for any delay in providing the Works or any part of the Works under any contract incorporating the Terms or for any other failure to perform any of its obligations caused by any circumstances beyond its reasonable control (including, but not limited to) calamity, war or armed conflict, or the serious threat of the same, Governmental order or regulation, labour disputes, severe economic dislocation, or the bankruptcy, insolvency or failure of manufactures or contractors of the raw materials to the Contractor beyond the reasonable control of the Contractor.

7. Waiver

The failure of the Contractor at any time to require full performance by the Customer shall in no manner affect the right of the Contractor to subsequently enforce such performance.

8. Construction

Any contract containing the Terms shall in all respects be deemed to be a contract made in New Zealand and the construction, validity and performance of such contract shall be governed by New Zealand law.

9. Limitation of Liability

If the Works are provided to the Customer by the Contractor for the purposes of a business, then:

- The Contractor's sole liability in respect of any breach of any obligation of the Terms shall be limited to remedying any deficiency in the Works that are shown to the Contractor's satisfaction to exist.
- The Contractor shall not in any circumstances be liable for incidental or consequential loss or damage arising from any breach of the Terms by the Customer.

10. Quality/Performance

- The Contractor warrants that in relation to the Works the services provided by the Contractor will be carried out with reasonable skill and care and any goods supplied shall be free from defects in workmanship or material.
- Except as expressly provided by paragraph 10(a), all terms, conditions, warranties and stipulations implied by Statute or otherwise are expressly excluded to the extent allowed by law.

11. Time of Completion

- Unless otherwise fixed or implied in any contract containing the Terms the Contractor warrants that the Works shall be performed within a reasonable time having due regard however to adverse weather conditions and other factors reasonably beyond the control of the Contractor. The Contractor is under no liability or responsibility for any loss, damage or expense incurred by the Customer as a result of delay in the completion of the Works caused by adverse weather conditions or other factors reasonably beyond the control of the Contractor.
- The Contractor may suspend providing the Works to the Customer if the Customer is in default of the Terms, without affecting the Contractor's other rights.

12. Agreement to Mortgage
