The short story....

Motivated by the inclusion of a broad array of highly sort after specialist providers (30). A magnetism of over 280 patrons of a mixed ages, both female and male, families and of multi ethnic groups attended each day. Support from Kindergarten - Kohanga Reo mokopuna, schools, Te Pu O Te Wheke and community.

Mini consultations, advice, general sharing, information seeking and simply curiosity prompted engagements. Recommended treatments, delivery, participation, and togetherness was receptively re-laid in positive feedback and outcomes.

Funds were expended effectively in aligned in allowing the Kaikohekohe community to participate to heavily reduced practices, treatments, products, if not free, workshops, external creative activities, spot prizes, quiz prices and tamariki corner prizes, prop preparations and event consumables. Marketing. Volunteer contributions. Complimenting to discounted delicious food throughout this event, guitar, and poetry evening.

Benefits generated shared in campaigning for more natural health services and subsidies, more health expos, to form a social enterprise as the LYW health collective, as healers, natural health providers, mo rongoa collective, follow up clinics and engage with local tourism groups in offering bike tours, Hokianga - Waipoua tours and Ngawha Springs

offering Holistic weekend packages. Having liken to seasonal events as such rotating across the mid north.

Shopping locally- positive coffee choices, noted limited healthy options- GF,V and DF dining out and accommodation ok.

Overall a positive collective consciousness, delivered, established, and composed to a very successful event!

The long story....

This the sixth (6) natural and traditional health exhibition of this scale and of its kind being held in this area. As we are aware natural and traditional therapies are not well supported in the Western model of healthcare. Under Te Riiti O Waitangi, recognition of Dr Mason Durie, Te Whare Tapa Wha health model created a pathway for such practices within Ministry of Health in Aotearoa New Zealand.

Setting the intent....The 'Mauri'-life force is about empowering people to be there best in health and wellbeing lifting their vibration. Offering an array of natural and traditional practices to and for the people. Both now and in the near future.

Collative consciousness and efforts bought to you under the guidance, insights, passion- driven commitment of a small group of Maori therapists, their friends, associates, greater networks, and families had created the ideas and implemented these at the LTW health expos.

Secondary advice was sort form Maori leaders, in regard to Kaikohekohe heritage and the synchronicity of Maramataka -nautical direction of planning for new projects and Matariki - Celebrating the Maori new year were paramount to this event timing and delivery.

Lighting the Way(LTW) and this event ran in conjunction with the Matariki Light Festival at Te Pu O Te Wheke Gallery at the request of people for the people. Shared interests to the "Lighting" creative tamariki assemblies' instrumental in making the glow tunnel, helping with event props and art activities as need be, that was displayed and utilized interactively as a playground at the community gallery thru Matariki. The guitar night and poetry night also were run in combination by means to this LTW event.

Matariki 'powhiri' was on the 1st of June 2018. Called to serve also embraced this holistic wellbeing "Oranga" arm of Lighting the Way Winter Wellness Matariki festival. The two-day timeframe duration for this event was marked by the new moon- associated with the world universal light activation...celebrations of Matariki Pleiades the star cluster that Maori ancestral practices followed.

Liken to turning on a starth...lifting and lighting the way. For new direction, for change, for clearing, for strength, for understand, for forgiveness, for information and human experience. A process that teaches individuals to take back and be responsible for our own health in its entirety (Mana). Set intent for healing to everyone of this community, trauma of the land, intergenerational trauma, love, compassion and togetherness- lifting the spirit(mauri).

The diversity of site holder's academia, skills, knowledge, depth of expertise, years of experience is over 200 years together. The teachings in Maramataka and tikanga even older- ancient practices in a modern world.

This event dealt in all aspects of health and primary care psychology and rehabilitation. The site holders both invited and volunteered themselves from many walks of life. Some hold completely different day jobs to what they presented and provided at event. Some regular followers of health expo both ,Australia and abroad. Some were insistent in telling us they were called to Kaikohe to help this community. Some providers were completely new to public presentation-this being there first general public event experience.

LTW group have set a high precedent of providers to these events which require the appropriate qualifications to health practice and/or letters of support indication length and time in services and product validationie patented or sanctioned under a national organization as example Mo rongoa under -Te Teriiti O Waitangi, counselling to NZCSA, massage to Massage Institute and so forth.

The environment was set up in exhibition cubicle sized sites around the circumference of the hall and back to back down the middle as indicated on site plan. Providers strategically placed side by side to synergies for best energy and safe practice. 30 sites in total. This year we used the stage area to present the screening of 'He Oranga Pumau' and various workshop presentations thru out both days.

He Oranga Pumau....a short documentary of a Hokainga woman (Tanya Filia) journey living with a an aggressive brain tumor, her treatments both mainstream and natural, challenges and execution. This screening draw interests from many...Maori Television Te Karea interviewed Tanya at LTW event. Invitations to further screening have been sort after across the motu and into Parliament.

The building itself took a bit of heating (costly at \$2 per 15 minutes for in house heating system) however eventually in addition to letting the sunlight in was warm and comfortable.

Free entry to over 280 people greatly received each Festival day. This was calculated in an aged and ethic group listing on the Friday - entrants counted in totality on the Saturday with a click device.

Site holders had reported a steady flow of engagement. Provider feedback patrons were so excited going to get friends and family and returning for more same day and next day.

Readings and bodywork services highest in demand, awaiting and wanting for future. Simply people want insights and have sore bodies.

Overall promoting a huge range of service to service questions, expression of interests and plenty of demand.

All participants asked, reported having achieved a positive service and products at this event.

All ages including children and elderly received bodywork. Some providers had relished the moments of exchanging treatments for themselves.

...what was available?

Our gate(door) keepers were able to direct patrons to the appropriate site holder for specialist treatment. Being Matekite themselves were able to scan aura for directive perceptions.

One noted feedback, to this event 'flyer' being a universal salute to the universe beside the Hone Heke monument itself. What started as a controversial subject was consoled by the sharing of the calling, guidance shared. Which lead to interesting conversations especially too the whakapapa, history of Hone Heke and Hone Hika and to the land itself and stories of old and where we were reflected today...patron able to articulate as direct descendant.

The Healing Blue Buddha bathed in healing water from the Rangihamana spring joined us making avail the cleansing process for kohatu, pounamu and sharing karakia for to clearing houses. Principles and philosophies of sharing universal laws, blessings of all creeds and receiving of nature's gifts. Patrons were taught how to cleanse their own taonga and take away karakia to do the own homes and land.

Soulwithin had static displays with valuable information on EFT Tapping- a process which requires gently tapping meridian points of the face, instilling positive intent in thought to change negative thoughts and unblock hindered energies system of the systemic body. Very simple, free and child friendly. Drawing interests from parents and teachers to implement (with younger children to set easy, real, good and positive intent to their day.)

Cerules Stemcell nutrition, one of the world's leading end microalgae nutrition's was vastly questioned. Testimonial booklet had generated different conversations as people wanted to know what was good for what, what is it, where is it sourced from, how it works, where you get it from and how much. The booklet had two Northland people in it, which made more real, tangible, and doable. A 'free draw giveaway' valued at \$90 had capsulated listed interests of 12 people. Four of which today are taking the products.

Tapuwae Foot and Ankle Podiatry checks was kept busy. With extended question to foot/toe diseases and so forth. Importance of good foot wear, foot placement and foot care. This service left with a good-sized follow up list of patrons. Some patrons did shy away with the thought of having smelly feet- all the more to have the conversation.

House of Hair and Nails DNA due to family bereavement.

Ngati Hine Health Trust joined this event, sharing information in and around organization service delivery in the area specifically to the youth services. Well received, interactive enquiry and information taken away.

MC, Mr Music thrilled, entertained, and capture the audience with an array of healing sounds. Some home composed guitar tunes. Set the tone perfectly the entire event. Well received and commented by patrons.

Gutt Health, tens testing machine-assisting consultation serviced 18 happy patrons...with an array of described tinctures, creams, and balms available. Receptively whelming, interests, questions of all sorts for all sorts of ailments. Delicate conversations to pain and rehabilitation relief.

Gold coin, 'one card' spirit guide and angel card readings, proved effectively direct, quick easy and well received. Delivered by a world renowned psychic medium of more than 30 years' experience both live and on radio thrilled patrons... surprised asking, do I know who she Is. This event and direct contact with patrons has inspired interests to have weekly mediation and spiritual development classes.

An introduction of the luxurious massage machine had proven well received and later in the day sort after. Given 10 to 30 minute back treatments/ massage left people in delightful bliss.

Massage Chair services proved consistently very busy. The youngest patron being 8 years old. Overall services more occupied by men. A massage therapy combination of pressure point release and massage always trumped cubing the stresses of the day. Very happy recipients all round.

Medicinal Intuitive was also well received. Patrons relaxed and wowed by the gentle practice of Reiki. Many a question to each individual needs. Patrons reported feeling from 'great to amazing' after receiving service.

Contact C.A.R.E- Flinchlock therapy was also very well received. With four (4) therapists. A therapy based on skeletal sensory shock this practice unlocks the cause relieving the overall body stresses. Patrons reported fulfilled with this service and in some cases having the whole family attended to. Youngest patron being 3 years old.

Starcraft Healing, a very gentle dual practice combination of amethyst biomatt and Reiki delivered by a Reiki master, left its patrons in total ecstasy. The explanation of gem stone essences, there placement to a line the body really informative for some reported patrons.

Healing with Tohu & Tarot was well received and awaited on time after time. Crystal and card readings, Rongoa Maori, Mirimiri Koo and Tao. This practice encompassed medium guidance was

hugely sort after. All supported patrons reported very pleased with their treatment. A follow up list of patrons was also collated.

Mo rongoa-a holistic practice regarding land ,sea plants/ecology was well received and decidedly requested. Having the tutor from our rohe ngahere, gave patrons the direct insights of both land and plant information and to next courses and what's ahead in the Mo Rongoa industry.

One other, Mo rongoa site holder had joined us in testimony to Rongoa Maori saving her life. As a survivor of cancer twice over she wanted to share her journey and new acclaimed hobby (in part) of mo rongoa. Very valuable, informative and appreciated by all whom made contact.

Our Kohatu Taonga are always a delight beyond words. These gifts of nature are forever evolving as with their essence and presence. A not to be missed stall of gifted explanation, taonga can be worn as necklaces, earrings, spectacular jewelry, and dowsing pendulums. Imploding negative energies. Provider brings 30 years' experience in this field and numerology.

As too, was the display, knowledge and explanations of the exquisite 'Te Wai Pounamu" on display from another site holder. Green stone off here very own papakainga in the south island embraced another element of beauty present.

Snazzy gifts bought to the event an over whelming display of gifts from A to Z. Everything imaginable to spiritual growth and development: books, cards, pendulums, gem trees, posters, wall hangings, gem doorway screens, Himalayan seal salt lamps, wall hangings, gemstones of all shapes and sizes and more. Very well received and patrons pleased with prices too. Provider happy to offer a postage deal to patrons from this area wanting to purchase after this event.

"Make a Wish", was a space created for patrons to write and display their said Matariki Wish Upon a Star. These wishes ranged from 'a cure for cancer', peace, love, harmony, thoughts to loved ones that had passed, to X box, lotto, for my dad to come home.... Space quadrupled as a resting space, a photo booth and "thank you" board, to sponsors, FNDC community funds.

Our attending Youth Mental coordinator introduced 'sand therapy' and 'drama in movement' using coloured scarves was interesting and captured the younger audience. Good feedback from parents and grandparents also impressed with their tamariki mokopuna engagement.

Medium spirit readings delivered for the first time in a public arena. (Previous two years' service delivery for this site holder had been online to one on one - international audience.) This event experience she said to be steady, herself was impressed with the engagement and positive environment, making comfortable clear delivery to patrons. Win win!

Healing hands broadened her expertise in a dual delivery of reading energy healing and tarot readings. Well sort after, received and very happy patrons. Win, win!

Counselling and hypnotherapy...captured patrons engagements more from a 'what is 'perspective. Feedback was positive all round. A note to record, was to let community know

that these services are now available in mental health services to Hokianga Health Trust. Patrons reported engagement was interesting and didn't know until then, how beneficial hypnotherapy could be. A patron that expressed having a negative experience in the past with a councilor reported a renewed faith in counselling after meeting this provider.

Family Constellation informed patrons of its processes, testimonies and participated in onsite workshops. A healing process using one person's story and other members of the group sharing sensory awareness to the given story. Universal principles that works in a cause and effect consciousness with individual and family, in sighting whakapapa healing, intergenerational trauma, connecting unknown heritage bringing clarity, guidance and insightful information to patrons that attended the workshops. Well received, kept, and inspired groups and families of followers. These providers will be running monthly sessions after this event.

Our counselor who doubles as an animal whisperer was inundated with questions on animal training, breaking horses in and general animal care. She is primarily an associate counsellor and expressed excitement just in be here to join us for the time.

Emotional coding provider expressed her site was slow in service requests but busy in questions of curiosity which was good in the end as patrons were happy to engage in follow up clinic. A practice that based around how to release tapped emotions...trapped in energies, toxicity, circulation, pathogens, structural and nutrition assimilation. Explanations of how emotionally charged past events can affect people today. Emotions are energy in motion that can be release by asking a sequence of questions pertaining to as in the answer needed to the release.

Te Kete O Te Ao Marama are ancient teachings, channeled thru mediums in land, sea and sky art-photography reading cards. Homemade by this provider. What is seen in the in the unseen, so to speak. As example when you look into the flames of a fire what do you see. The mind naturally scans the subconious mind for insights. This the true of what needs to be known. The light of the moon (te ao marama) the answer can be seen....this provider noted a steady interest in beauty and essence in pictures and expression on cards.

Gunineve medium...was continually kept busy, engaged and thrilled by the interests expressed by patron. A lot of very satisfied patrons. She too happy to follow up in the near future as event demand requested. Patrons testified readings "so accurate"," it blue then away"," its cool", 'yep really good".

Mini readings and Bach flowers essence was also well received and utilized. Follow up requests have been sorted for in the near future. Patrons described surprised their were such a selection of flower essences and information, exciting and informative. Some wanting to learn and attend yoga and any workshops that may happen in the future.

Tai Chi workshop....reported good attendance. And they all stuck it out till the end of the 45 minute session....this tutor is interested in offering a regular weekly group in town.

Rounding up providers on the floor is our laughter provider. His humor and story telling captured audiences steadily thru out each day. He moved in and around the crowds, making good connections and directing patrons to awaiting providers as he saw who was wanting to see who also. Our laughing conductor!

'Five plus a day', provider couldn't join us. However interests in the static display and material resource's helpful and patrons helped themselves accordingly. These included wall charts, coloring competitions, book markers, black board info /chalks, food pyrimad and calenders.

Maramataka wall charts flew out the door quick smart. These guidance charts have information to best times for planting, harvesting...growing and holistic ecology cycles.

The Potters Corner, took off in its own direction with patrons pleased to rehouse plants. Committing to seedling nursery and sharing products in the community garden. Happy to take away the composting, worm cast and potting mixtures to add to their own prepared gardens.

The Tamariki Corner is always a sensational. Everyone has the opportunity to pick up a ukulele and strum a tune or two....some adults conveyed having done so with great enthusiasm and excitement- thrilled that they completed playing the whole song and at how simple it was.

The little ones had their face paintings- looking very skillfully awesome little princess, butterflies, wolves, superheroes and more, storytelling, coloring in, drawing, alphabeatable- a tapping alphabet game where you challenge beating your own time, drafts, norts and crosses and connect four...competitively to win prizes(everyone who partiscipated won a prize!)

The Matariki Activity workbook made interesting resources for youth as these had word search in Maori and English, discover what, whats important, games, stories, food, whenua, and whanau and information pertaining to Matariki, Maramataka and meanings.

The Head, Heart and Hands Competition. An art project invitation to all the local schools. Was accepted with good enthusiasm, we captured some of these winning school posters -Kaikohe East School (as in the pictures). The story behind HHH was to give the children the opportunity to express what was the heart of the area, who they thought to be leaders of their school, who are the helpful people, families- themselves they valued and who cared the most around then and why. Teachers- principals reported some interesting stories where shared around the kaupapa together with their own in classes activities to Matariki. Enthralled to have the inclusion in this festival.

Marketing efforts....

Hard copy marketing was thru letterbox drops to Moerewa, Kawakawa, Pahia, Kaikohe, North and South Hokianga. Community 'Whats on', in the Northern News. Apparently, there was a post event write up we've not yet seen.

Roadside signage, was at all entries to Kaikohe, main street and outside the hall itself.

Coloured flyers posters placed across the mid north.

Black and white flyers handed to agencies, networks and organizations.

LTW health Expo Facebook page, website and FB friends, families, and associates.

Radio exposure with Radio Tauroko FM, Whangarei declined a community shout as we didn't fit into the region. We missed the breakfast show, community news on NZTV as emails issues hadn't made it to the recipients.

Consumables included part of resources to pre, during and post event.

A Health and Safety compliance check was completed by a NZ Worksafe associate.

H& S findings;

*Ceiling hanging ropes needed to be tied back and higher.

*Power points need to fixed.

NB risk-As a result providers had extension cords and joiners using power board on power board.

*The on the stage at the right side banister needs replacing as very loose and unstable.

*Heating?...consideration to a stir fan at center hall roof to send warm air back around the room.

*A 'caution indicator-tape' on the step in doorway to entry of hall.
