NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS AS AT 31 MARCH 2018

NOTE 1 - STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES

REPORTING ENTITY

The Kaikohe Business Association is an Incorporated Society under the Incorporated Societies Act 1908. The financial statements of the Kaikohe Business Association Incorporated have been prepared in accordance with the requirements of that Act.

The Kaikohe Business Association Incorporated is an association established to foster economic development in Kaikohe and the surrounding areas.

The Kaikohe Business Association is a reporting entity. These Financial Statements have been prepared in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles.

MEASUREMENT BASE

The general accounting policies recognised as appropriate for the measurement and reporting of results, cash flows and financial position under the historical cost method have been followed in the preparation of these financial statements. Reliance is placed on the fact that the Club is a going concern. Accrual accounting is used to match expenses and revenues.

SPECIFIC ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Accounts Receivable

Accounts Receivable are shown at the amount due, after allowance for bad debts

Bad Debts

Bad debts are recorded only when actually written off as bad.

Fixed Assets

Fixed assets are recorded initially at their original purchase cost. The assets have not been depreciated.

Investments

Investments are stated at the lower of cost or realisable market value. Investment income, other than dividend income, is recognised on an accruals basis where appropriate.

Taxation Position

The association is a registered charity. Charitable activities undertaken by the association are not subject to income tax.

Goods and Services Tax

The financial statements have been prepared on a GST exclusive basis except for Accounts Receivable and Accounts Payable. Any tax outstanding at balance date is disclosed in the Statement of Financial Position.
