The current Awanui park has the potential to become a multi purpose park for all to enjoy. The park will connect with the Awanui River by way of a crossing and timber wharf. There will be pedestrian links with the retirement village.






The playground boat is to be modeled on the Apanui that sailed in an out of Awanui via Rangauni Harbour

MUEHLENBECKIA COMPLEXA

A steel trace network around 3 sides of toilet block. This structure stepped off the building approx.800mm, provides access to maintain building. A steel gate locks access. to this space.

Plant muehlenbeckia complexa in garden bed in front of the sturcture. The old wharf poles feature historical images mounted at the top of poles. The plants require approximately 3 -4 years to acheive good growth cover. Grasses such as Oioi to be planted in front of Wire weed climber.


This area has recently had a post & rail fence constructed on boundary Now Commerical signage has arrive - Visual impact not positive


