**ROAD NAME:**

1. <b>First Choice</b> – Ohotu Way	From a whakatauki related to the naming of nearby Roto Tangonge & an old land block here. Also said to be abbreviation of Tamahotu - te tamaiti a Tumoana o te waka Tinana
2. Second Choice – Otararau Lane	Another old land block in this vicinity, perhaps to do with the noiseness of the birds in the forest there.
3. Third Choice – Koroī Lane	Also taken from the whakatauki mentioned above, speaks of the groves of kahikatea & their berries as kai. Remnant trees still grow near Tangonge
