This includes strengthening the Pacific community's awareness about their own cultures, advocating for Pacific people's needs as well as promoting good education, health and wellbeing.

Our reach with our Pacific communities is from the Te Hiku iwi boundaries extending from Cape Reinga to the Hokianga.

Along with the social services provider, Fale Pasifika Te Tai Tokerau in Whangarei, we are the only other Pacific organisation for Pasifika peoples located in the Far North District.

As a newly formed Trust, and all the challenges that come with that as well as dealing with COVID related impacts, we remain focused on meeting the needs and struggles of our Pasifika families.
